



Ten \$1,500 Scholarships

Scholarship Criteria

- Applicants must be planning to attend one of the ten interior post-secondary institutions in the fall of 2017 (see list of 'Post-Secondary Institutions' on the left). Entering a program during 2nd semester of 2018 is acceptable as well.
- Preference will be given to students <u>entering a forestry-related program (see list of 'Fields of Study' on right)</u>. Students entering other areas of study may apply, knowing there is a preference for forestry related study.
- Scholarships in the amount of \$1,500 will be awarded on receipt by COFI of documentation confirming registration and proof of payment (copy of tuition receipt) at an approved post—secondary institution.
- Scholarships have to be used for the 2017-18 academic year, <u>no deferrals of</u> scholarships allowed
- Incomplete applications will not be considered for the scholarship.
- The decision of the scholarship committee is final.

 A copy of your most recent Transcript from High School.

2. Written Letter

A one-page letter from you outlining your educational goals, how you think you qualify for this scholarship, and your plans for future employment in the forest industry.

3. Two letters of Reference

Reference letters can be from your principal, classroom teacher, a community reference, and/or past/current employer.

 Successful applicant will be requested to complete a Photo Release form and a jpeg photo for publication purposes.
