Welcome, from the St. Ann's Faith Development Team (FDT)

What is the Faith Development Team?

The FDT is made up of parent volunteers and school staff members who are passionate about sharing our Catholic faith. In addition to our steering committee, we also have Faith Reps who are glad to answer questions about our faith and rituals, or connect you with someone who can answer your questions! Our mission is to be companions, encouraging a Catholic way of life and accompanying others to deepening an understanding of our faith. We want to inspire the St. Ann's Academy community to grow in the love of our Lord Jesus through the Word and Sacramental life! We accomplish these goals by supporting teachers in their teaching of the faith to our students, by sharing faith-based resources with school families via email and social media, and by building community through our relationships with students, teachers and families.

Who is part of the Faith Development Team?

Our Steering Committee is made up of a few parent volunteers, devoted teachers, our school principal, and our pastor. Our Faith Reps are parent volunteers who are willing to connect with other parents, and are happy to share our Catholic faith with others. Faith Reps commit to a one-year term and parents and/or guardians are welcome to become a Faith Rep or a Steering Committee member.

What is a FDT meeting like?

Our Steering Committee currently meets monthly on the third Tuesday, at 3:15 pm. Meetings are typically 45 - 60 minutes in length and provide updates on faith-based opportunities and activities in the school and in our parent community. Our Parent Faith Reps also meet regularly to build fellowship and grow in faith together. Any parent is welcome to join our Faith Rep meetings as an opportunity to connect or to learn more about the Catholic faith; contact us to find out when we will meet next.

Parent Participation Hours

Involvement in the FDT as either a Steering Committee member or as a Parent Faith Rep is eligible for the PPP. As it is an annual commitment, your PPP hours will be covered in entirety for that year.
