THE FOLLOWING ITEMS MUST BE SUPPLIED BY HOME:

- Emergency clothing in a bag- a pair of underwear, socks, t-shirt, sweatpants or leggings.
- **Small** Blanket and stuffed animal (for quiet time) this item stays at school so should not be your child's favourite!
- Indoor shoes (non-marking runners for PE class with Velcro unless your child is able to tie his/her own shoes)
- Outdoor runners for PE in warmer weather
- Outdoor shoes (closed toe and closed heel no sandals)
- Lunch kit and Backpack
- 6 large Ziploc bags (labelled clearly with child's name)

Please make sure all items are clearly labelled with your child's name

Physical Education classes: all students are required to have a pair of indoor (non-marking soles only) and outdoor runners for Physical Education classes. St. Ann's Academy gym strip is required for Grades 1 through 7 PE classes (**Kindergarten students do not change for P.E.**)

Limited Quantity of School Supplies: SAA will provide students with the school supplies listed above. Please note these supplies may need to be replenished throughout the school year.

Label all belongings: please put your child's name on all of the clothing they wear to school. This will help students identify uniform items especially when changing for Physical Education classes. Please label shoes, shirts, pants, sweaters, gym strip, gym bags and outdoor items.
