For God so loved the world that He gave his only Son, so that everyone who believes in him might not perish but might have eternal life. John 3:16 The Stations of the Cross is a prayerful meditation on the Passion and Death of Jesus Christ. There are many formats, but all reflect on 14 Stations that mark important milestones of Jesus' suffering for our salvation.

Hallow is a Catholic prayer and meditation app with an incredible amount of content. Need a "mindful minute"? Maybe a guided meditation? Hallow has these and more. The Catholic Independent Schools - Kamloops Diocese (CISKD) has purchased a subscription so that all families in the region may access the full content! To try it out, email the school office with your request, and include your first and last name, your email address, and your role within the school - parent, student, staff - Hallow will create your full access account and notify you!

FORMED provides the very best Catholic content from more than 60 organizations to help parishes, families and individuals explore their faith anywhere. As a St Ann's family, you have access to FORMED on your mobile device or computer, for free! To check it out, download the FORMED app, or visit <u>FORMED.org</u>. Click on the "SIGN UP" button, click on "SIGN UP AS A PARISHIONER", type in "SACRED HEART CATHEDRAL KAMLOOPS", click on the link for the parish and click "NEXT", and enter your NAME and EMAIL to set up your account (Phew. It's a lot - but it's worth it!). As your first explore, check out THE SEARCH, a 7-part video series that would be perfect for Lent! It is a family-friendly series, with lots of opportunities for discussion with your spouse, teens and young adults. If you have younger children, check out the section for families and kids!

NEWS FROM THE SAA OFFICE

RE-REGISTRATION PACKAGES – Re-registration packages went home last week with the youngest sibling in each family. If your son or daughter was away, the re-registration package will be given to him or her on their first day back. A few things to note:

-Please read over the 'Student Verification Information Form' very carefully and correct and/or update mailing addresses, email addresses, medical history, etc. Please also ensure that there is at least one emergency contact on this form.

-Only one '2022-2023 RE-REGISTRATION' form was included in each package. Simply put the names and grades of all siblings on this one form.

-Please have your re-registration package returned to the school office by **Friday**, **March 11th** @ **12:00pm**.

REPORT CARDS – Report cards will be going home with on Friday, March 11th. Report cards will **not be available** prior to Friday, March 11. If your child/children are away from school on March 11, they may pick up their report card when they return to school after spring break.

ATTENDANCE – REMINDER FOR ATTENDANCE

At the beginning of the new school year in September the start time for school was changed from 8:30 am to 8:25 am. This means students should be arriving at 8:20 am at the latest in order to be present in their classes by 8:25. If students are arriving after 8:25 am they will need to stop by the office for a late slip so they are not marked absent. Thank you all for making this necessary adjustment in your schedules.

REPORTING A STUDENT ABSENCE - Thank you to our parents for diligently reporting their child's absence(s). Please note that it is very important for student absences to be reported and for students to check in at the office if they're coming late or leaving early. In the event of something such as a fire drill (or worse an actual fire!), we have to ensure that *every* student is accounted for. BUSES

A reminder that if your son or daughter only rides the bus occasionally, he or she MUST have a bus pass from the school office. The bus passes are \$3.50 and they must be shown to the driver or the student will not be permitted to ride the bus that day. Please also note that even if bus usage is only occasional, students must be pre-registered to ride that particular bus, as space is limited.

SCHOOL PICK-UP

Thank you parents for your continued patience with our pick up lines! We're getting the hang of it! HOWEVER, please DO NOT use the roundabout for pick up or drop off. The roundabout is reserved for buses and students with special needs. It is NOT to be used by anyone else. We also kindly ask that you don't pull into spots along the south wall (on the far side of the parking lot from the school) as these are specifically assigned to staff. We've had a few staff show up to work and vehicles are parked in their spots. Please use the designated Visitor spots if you need to park. Thank you!!
