MUNCH-A-LUNCH — Please be sure to send payments for munch-a-lunch to **payments@st-anns.ca** and to indicate who and what it is for in the message section.

UNIFORMS — Please see the <u>Top Marks Uniform Order Information</u> with information on our school uniform supplier and how to order school uniforms. Also, be sure to check on the St. Ann's Parent Connect Facebook page for any gently-used uniforms that other parents may be selling.

ATTENDANCE - At the beginning of the new school year in September the start time for school was changed from 8:30 am to 8:25 am. This means students should be arriving at 8:20 am at the latest in order to be present in their classes by 8:25. If students are arriving after 8:25 am they will need to stop by the office for a late slip so they are not marked absent. Thank you all for making this necessary adjustment in your schedules.

REPORTING A STUDENT ABSENCE — Please, please and pretty please try to remember to use the attendance@st-anns.ca email for reporting absences so that they go directly to our attendance secretary, Arlene. If they come to me at officeadmin@st-anns.ca, Arlene may still be calling or emailing to ask if your son or daughter is absent because I don't always get them to her quickly enough. Thank you to our parents for diligently reporting their child's absence(s). Please note that it is very important for student absences to be reported and for students to check in at the office if they're coming late or leaving early. In the event of something such as a fire drill (or worse an actual fire!), we have to ensure that *every* student is accounted for. Your children's safety is important to us:)

BUSES - A reminder that if your son or daughter only rides the bus occasionally, he or she MUST have a bus pass from the school office. The bus passes are \$3.50 and they must be shown to the driver or the student will not be permitted to ride the bus that day. Please also note that even if bus usage is only occasional, students must be pre-registered to ride that particular bus, as space is limited.
