Tis the season for re-registration. We currently have wait lists for students in most grades. Re-registration packages have been sent home with the family couriers on Thursday February 22, 2024. Packages are due back by **NOON on March 7th.** We will be accepting applications and opening placement for non-SAA students after the deadline. Please note if your re-registration package is not returned by the March 7th deadline, a placement may not be available for your student(s) in September 2024. For any re-registration packages received after the March 7th deadline, a \$50 late fee will be charged and must be paid before your re-registration is considered.
